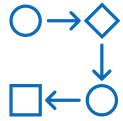

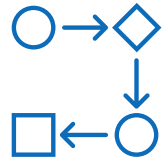

PDSES Program Overview

What is PDSES?



The PDSES program gives a \$1,500 one-time grant to families of Texas public school students served through special education. Families are given access to an online account where they can use this money to purchase educational goods and services for their student.

What can families purchase?



With PDSES accounts, families can purchase **educational goods** and **services** from the PDSES marketplace.

EDUCATIONAL GOODS SUCH AS:

- Books
- School Supplies
- Laptops
- Sensory Items
- Tablets
- Therapeutic Items

SERVICES SUCH AS:

- Tutoring
- Social Skills
- Therapy
- Camps

Who is eligible?



To be eligible for a PDSES grant, students must currently:

- be enrolled in a Texas public school (EE-12th grades),
- receive special education services through an individualized education program (IEP), **and**
- not have received a PDSES grant in the past.

PDSES is a ONE TIME only grant.

The “Student Lookup” can only find the student’s unique identification number (UID) if the correct Social Security number (SSN) or Student number (S#) is provided. The student’s SSN or an S# must match the one that was used when your student was registered. If an SSN was not used when the student first registered, the school will have given an S#. These start with the letter “S” and have eight digits.

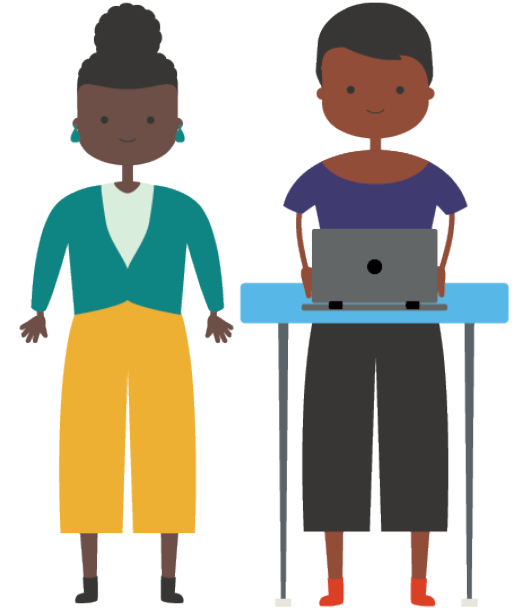

IMPORTANT: The information you provide MUST match state records. Include any special characters.

A UID is a 10-digit number given to each student in a Texas public school. It is used by the state to identify students without using their social security numbers. The UID is different from a local ID number that may be given by your school district (i.e., Student ID or District ID). You can use the “Student Lookup” in the PDSES Parent Portal in the “Add a Student” page OR, you can contact your student’s school.

UIDs are different than a local ID provided by the district.

1 Add student(s) – Student Lookup

After entering all your student's information, the fields should be green. Next, click "Search"

You only need to enter your student's UID or their SSN/S#. The PDSES program does not collect or save SSNs or S#s.





IMPORTANT: Adding your student to your profile does not mean that you have applied for your student. To do that you must wait for the application window to open and then click “Apply” next to your student’s information on the homepage.

Before you can click the “Submit Application” button, you must complete three steps:



PDSES Application

PDSES Account Activation Requirement:

All awarded applicants must complete the PDSES Account Activation Requirement within 30-days of the day their award notice was sent by email. Completing the PDSES Account Activation Requirement means that you must log on to your online ClassWallet Marketplace account and accept the PDSES Parental Acknowledgement and Agreement after you log in. If an awarded applicant does not complete the PDSES Account Activation Requirement within 30-days, account funds may be reclaimed.

You only need to upload documentation if your student recently became eligible for PDSES (after October of the current school year). If your student:

- **Began receiving special education services** - if you are applying for a student whose individualized education program (IEP) paperwork show special education services started after October of the current school year, you should upload their IEP as part of the application process.
- **Started attending a Texas public school** - if you are applying for a student that enrolled in a Texas public school after October of the current school year, you should upload their most recent IEP.

Digital files such as PDFs are required. You should contact your student's school for a digital copy of your student's IEP. If you need help, please visit this site for tips— [PDSES Parent Portal FAQs](#).

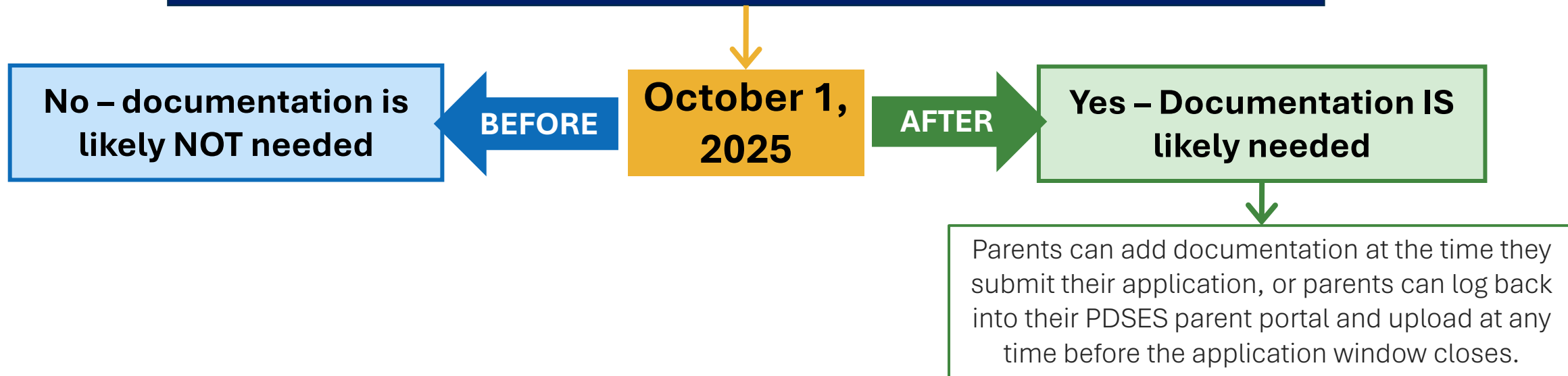

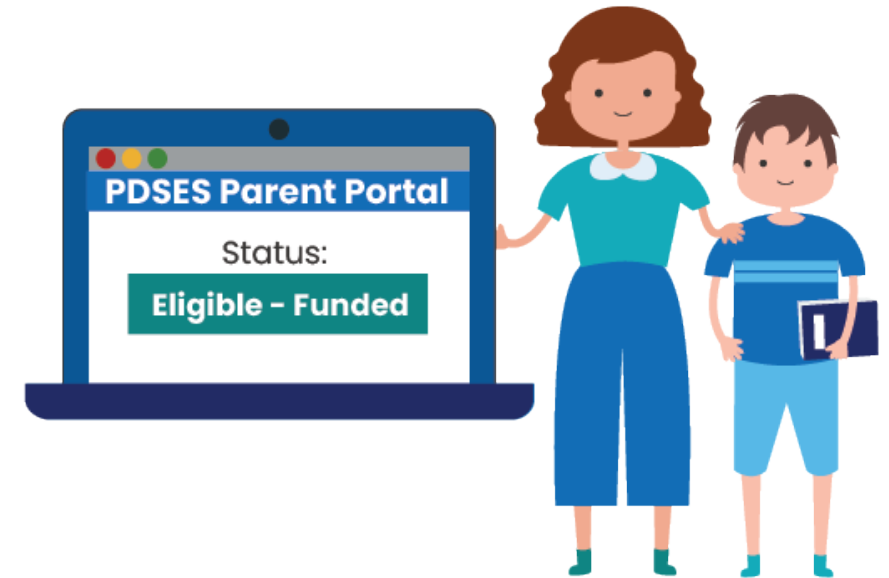
When do parents need to upload documentation?

When did the student begin receiving services for special education
AND when did they enroll in a Texas public school?



Note: For most applications, state data will determine eligibility and the extra step of uploading documentation will not be necessary.

- You can log back into your PDSES parent portal at anytime to check the status of your application.
 - *Applications will not be processed until after the application window has closed. Your status will remain “Submitted” or “Submitted with Attachments” until it is processed.*
- You will receive an email each time your application status changes.



Please be patient

It will take the PDSES team time to process your application and provide your award decision.

Once you are awarded a PDSES account...

You will receive an email from ClassWallet with instructions on accessing and using your account funds.



Access the PDSES Marketplace (ClassWallet) to purchase educational resources or services.

Complete the account activation within the first 30-days, including logging in and signing the PDSES Parental Agreement.

Spend grant funds before the purse deadline – you will receive this date in an email if you have been awarded an account.

Top Rejected Items by Category

Parents must follow PDSES purchasing guidelines when purchasing items for their student.
PDSES purchases must provide a direct educational benefit to the student.



PDSES* Purchasing Guidelines

As stated in the [Parent Directed Special Education Services \(PDSES\) Parental Acknowledgment and Agreement](#), the funds in the PDSES Account are for the educational benefit of the eligible student(s) and are not to be used for other purposes. **Items and services requested for purchase should be those that the student will directly use to access the educational curriculum.** More specifically, items and services requested should serve a direct educational benefit.

Families are allowed to purchase **ONE** computer (laptop or desktop) **AND ONE** tablet (iPad) per eligible student. Any additional requests for either of these items will not be allowed.

The following items are **NOT** allowed under PDSES purchasing guidelines:

- Cleaning supplies – including paper towels, dish soap, and mops/brooms/vacuums.
- Home goods – including coffee makers, kitchen items, tools, and appliances.
- Home security – including surveillance and doorbell cameras.
- Smart Speakers and Streaming Devices – including Alexa devices, Google Assistants, Rokus, and Firesticks.
- General furniture – NOT including desks, chairs, or organizational items for direct learning.
- Food or drinks – including bottles of water.
- Medical supplies – including first aid kits, thermometers, air purifiers, or hygiene items.

The following items have a price threshold – this list below does not include all possible thresholds:

- Headphones - \$250
- Printers - \$400
- Monitors - \$300
- Desks - \$300
- Desk Chairs - \$200
- Sports equipment - \$100
- Speakers - \$100
- Microphones - \$100

Additionally, items are subject to review based on the number of the same items requested. If it is determined to be an excessive quantity the order may be rejected.

If you are purchasing an item that may be considered questionable, or you wish to purchase an item that costs more than its threshold, you should provide a justification for your purchase request. This justification should highlight the direct educational benefit and the educational goal this product will help your child achieve.

*The PDSES program is the same as the SSES program, just with a new name to better reflect the importance of parents as decision makers in the educational process. Any reference to Supplemental Special Education Services Program, supplemental special education services, supplemental special education services instructional materials, or SSES in state law and TEA materials is to be considered synonymous with the PDSES program." 19 TAC §102.1601(j).

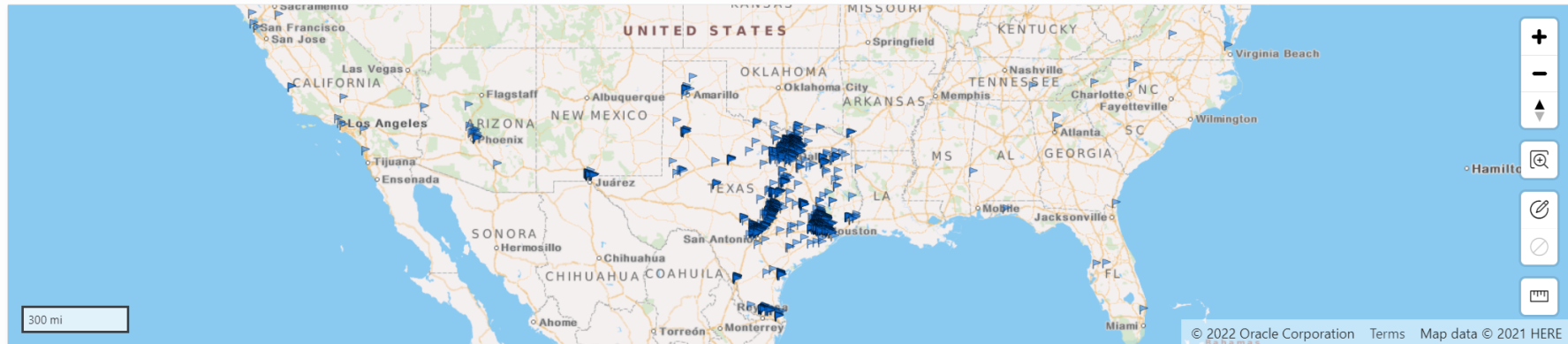
